L'Arche Manchester is expanding. We are a vibrant, growing, faith-based community of people with and without learning disabilities as well as a professional support and care provider.

We work toward a society where all belong – regardless of ability or disability – in which each person and their gifts are celebrated and valued. Relationship, friendship and celebration are central to our life together.

We currently have vacancies for live-in and live-out assistants.

Live-out assistant salary starts at £8.25 an hour (min £16,088 pa.)

Live-in assistants receive board and lodgings and a stipend wage of £63 to £100 a week.

The role involves supporting people with learning disabilities at home and in our daytime support activities; supporting people to be part of their Community, enabling them to maximise their independence through the acquisition of new skills and increased social integration.

Subject to funding approval we are also hoping to recruit a part-time HR specialist to work with us three to four days a week. (At this point we are looking for expressions of interest.)
This would be a 24 hour a week post. Salary £24,458 (fte – based on 40 hours.)

Part-time and full-time roles are available and hours can be flexible. Roles involving home based support will involve evening and weekend working. Roles involving daytime only working are available within the daytime activity service.

Full training and induction for the role will be given on commencement of employment. LDQ/NVQ level 3 or Diploma in Health and Social Care is an advantage.
